

Junior/Young Amateur Exhibitor Scholarship!

The THJA will award three \$1,500 scholarships for education to junior and amateur exhibitors competing in THJA hunter/jumper horse shows.

Eligibility: THJA will award a \$1,500 scholarship to an equitation rider, a hunter rider, and a jumper rider. Applicants must be junior/amateur exhibitors with a THJA membership.

Application Requirements: Application must include application form, school transcript, and a one-page essay written by the applicant on what their participation in THJA horse shows means to them. In addition, a letter of recommendation is required. The letter may be emailed directly to Patty@memorialparkhunters.com and does not need to accompany the application.
